


Commons

A community resource system characterised by:

- Self management (~ commons governance)
- Accessible membership
- Shared knowledge
- Members have a right to participate, use, contribute to and fork (~ replicate)


Free and Open Licenses


- · Free licenses:
 - Rights: 4 freedoms*
 - Obligations: attribute authorship
- Copyleft, ShareAlike:
 - Obligation: modified/derivative works have to provide the same rights to others
- Permissive:
 - No obligations
- Open license:
 - Permits copying, but with some rights reserved:
 - NC: Non-Commercial
 - ND: No Derivative works
- Copyfair:
 - Like NC but allows commercial usage by companies owned by workers, cooperatives, non-profits, ...


